

## **Peculiar Aspects in Influence of $\alpha$ 1-Adrenoceptor Stimulation on Isolated Rat Heart**

### **Abstract**

© 2016 Springer Science+Business Media New York The study examined the effect of  $\alpha$ 1-adrenoceptor stimulation with methoxamine on chronotropic function of isolated heart perfused *ex vivo* according to Langendorff and cardiac chronotropy *in vivo*. Stimulation of  $\alpha$ 1-adrenoceptors in isolated heart induced gradually developing bradycardia, which progressed during several minutes. Similar stimulation *in vivo* produced a short-term bradycardia probably terminated by the compensatory influences in the whole organism. Comparison of the data obtained in both experimental paradigms during  $\alpha$ 1-adrenoceptor stimulation revealed unidirectional changes in cardiac chronotropy characterized with time-related peculiarities.
